



POGGIO AL MORO

Bolgheri Rosso DOC

Ruby red in color, the wine has aromas of black cherry, blackberry and plum. The palate is structured, with tannins that resonate in the finish, offset by sweet fruit, notes of underbrush and an acidity vibrant.



WINE IDENTITY

Alcohol content: 14,5%

Aging capacity: more than 10 years.



PRODUCTION AND VINIFICATION

Grape varieties:

- Cabernet Sauvignon
- Merlot
- Sangiovese
- Syrah

Vineyards:

- East/Southwest exposure.

Harvest: by hand, with careful selection of bunches.

Vinification: each variety is vinified separately in stainless steel tanks. Here spontaneous fermentation takes place at a controlled temperature, not exceeding 28-29°C, and maceration, for a period of about 20 days.

Maturing: the wine stays for about three months in French oak barrels. Subsequent aging in the bottle before being released.
